Pump Operator – Is stationed at the pump truck and provides area security

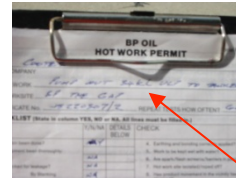
Pump Assistant – gives assistance were required.



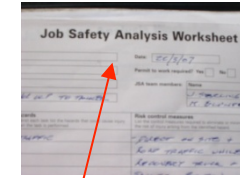
Emergency Response Planning

Area Gas Free confirmed

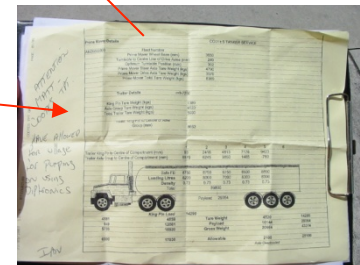


Appropriate paperwork completed.
