A TERP can help you to:

- think about emergency scenarios and plan for them
- determine who does what – roles, responsibilities, duties
- identify who has what resources and where they are - mobilise
- work together in a time of stress and crisis
- facilitate a rapid & effective response and recovery, minimising harm
- provide assistance to emergency and security services
- communicate with internal and external personnel
- cover your backside - from those possibly coming later
– ('what did you do?.....and where's your TERP?')
