

HV Speed Case Study

QLD B-double, >60 x detections, 111kph – 138kph





17 April 2018, 1930HRS, Yelgun Interchange, Pacific Highway (southbound)


ECM speed limiter = 141.3kph

Driver positive RDT (methamphetamine)
Cab search = radar detector, drugs
Major grounded defects:

- ECM
- Driver's seatbelt inoperative
- Passenger seat not bolted down
- Cracked windscreen
- Brakes both trailers, all push rods travel more than 80%
- B-double over length by 1.39m

Critical Fatigue Case Study

QLD B-double, Driver Direction: 7 hours rest




19 January 2018, 0834HRS, Jones Island HVIB

Critical fatigue breach: Driver direction = 7 hours rest

- Driver appeared dazed, eyes glassy, mumbling, drooping
- over steering wheel, slow reaction times
- Reported 'near-miss' on M1 at Mooney Mooney
- Attended to by Ambulance at Beresfield
- Minimal/poor sleep, disrupted by multiple calls from manager
- 6th day of driving
- No work diary entries
- Admitted to false and misleading entries
- Police called negative RBT/RDT
- Escorted to motel for 7 hours rest period

LPG Tanker, QLD B-double, Major Defects: Brakes







Major Defect Notices Issued - defective brakes

- Vehicle inspection found defective brakes on both "A" and "B" trailers
- "A" trailer: broken brake chamber, only attached to the trailer by pushrod rendering it inoperative. Rust detected on friction surface.
- "B" trailer: damaged and bent pushrod on one brake chamber
- "B" trailer: stroke indicator exposed with excess travel on another brake pushrod




