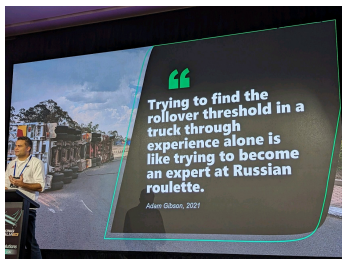

VTA State Conference and ATA's Trucking Australia 23 wrap up

The VTA State Conference was held in San Remo last week and the ATA's Trucking Australia conference is currently underway on the Sunshine Coast. It was great to see industry support these events and NBTA members and partners front and centre.

Highlights were presentations from Charles Bunker-Smith (Volvo,) Romesh Rodrigo (Daimler), Billy Addison (Haulmax Tyres), Ben Ditfort (MTData) and the Sal Petrocitto and Peter Anderson Q&A session. Adam Gibson (NTI) and Rachel Michaud (Knorr-Bremse) impressed at TA23 discussing tech solutions to the ongoing issue of truck rollovers.



Tunnel talk – Transurban looking for 1%

For our members who can use them, tunnels are all the talk at the moment. Phil Naulls, Transurban General Manager, explained at the VTA State conference that \$13M of high-tech lights have been installed in Melbourne's Burnley Tunnel, aiming to improve traffic flow by encouraging drivers to keep pace with the speed limit. Drivers on average are reducing their speed from 80 km/h to 65 km/h by the time they exit the tunnel. The paced lighting aims to encourage drivers to maintain their speed, the target is a 1% increase in traffic flow.

The NBTA is expecting the TAC/DoT Vic telematics trial to shine a light on congestion, key freight routes and road utilisation. Contact the NBTA if you'd like to participate in the telematics trial.

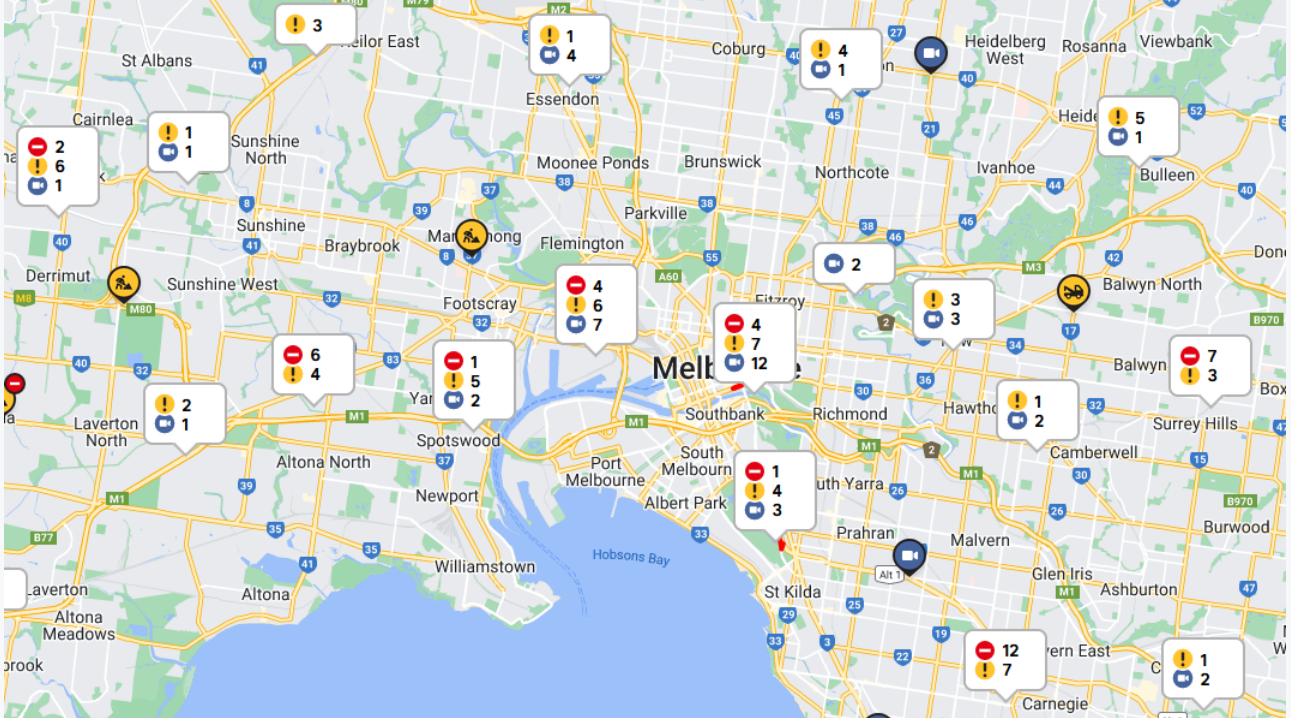

Major road closure in Melbourne to impact DG operators



The NBTA has been notified of the following works that may impact heavy vehicle drivers in Melbourne.

Sunday night closure of City Road and Power Street intersection, Southbank

The intersection of City Road and Power Street will be closed from **10pm, Sunday April 2 until 5am, Monday April 3** while asphalt is laid over the newly upgraded traffic lanes.

This is the route for operators unable to use the Burnley Tunnel.

Traffic will detour via Queens Bridge Street, Kavanagh Street and Southbank Boulevard. VMS boards, detour signage and traffic controllers will be on site to manage the flow of traffic. Drivers are advised to allow extra time for their journey, follow instructions from traffic controllers and drive safely.

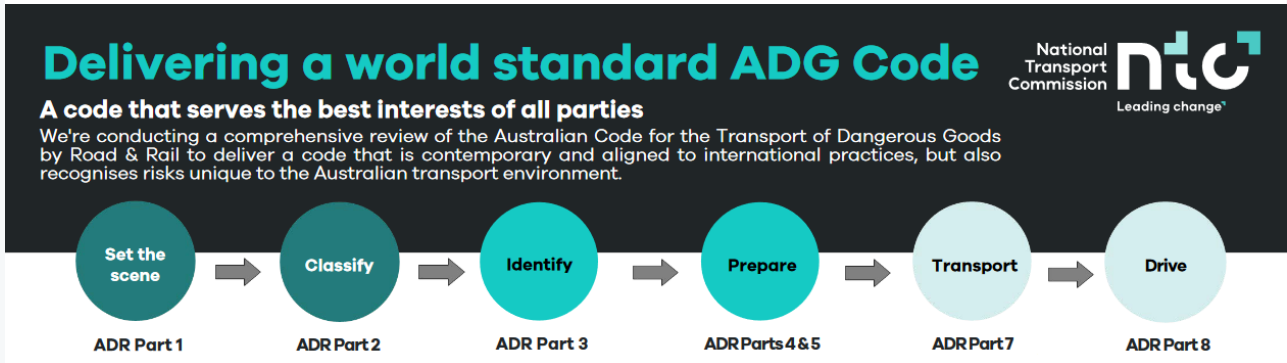
ADG Code review – new consultation open on approval of tanks, bulk containers and vehicles
