Quarterly Meeting highlights and presentations



Our final quarterly meeting for the year was held at the VTA in Port Melbourne.

Operation Cyclone

The highlights included presentations from the NHVR Compliance and Enforcement team. Derek Watt and Steven Holland shared the learnings from Operation Cyclone which focused on heavy vehicles carrying dangerous goods. Steven explained during the blitz the instruction was "if its got a placard pull it over". The NBTA members supported the initiative aimed to improved the standard across the sector and welcomed the sharing of information.

What we have found

Bulk Tankers - Positives

- Were found to be underrepresented in vehicle standards issues when compared to the general heavy vehicle fleet
- The trend for non-compliance is going down for tankers, compared to flat lining for the rest of the heavy vehicle fleet
- The tanker fleet is predominantly newer when compared to the general heavy vehicle fleet.
 - Prime movers 53% are less than 10 years old
 - Tanker trailers 45% are less than 10 years old
- Technology is a key factor and positively influences road safety in the tanker fleet generally.



Les Bruzsa, NHVR Chief Engineer presented the 2023 highlights in the strategic and policy space and Ian Mond, Vic DTP provided an update on access, bridge assessments and informed members of the release of the Austroads report on a risk based approach to tunnel access.

Anthony provided a summary of the new project "Learning from Near Misses" and Ross and Natalie from SuperFriend shared mental health stats for the transport industry.


